STUDENT CLASSROOM PLACEMENTS FOR THE NEXT YEAR

It is that time of year to be considering class placements for next year. Staff considers many factors as balanced groups are prepared, such as the range of academic abilities, social mixture, gender balance, individual learning styles, student personality and interaction, students benefiting from being together or separated, overall student behavior, student/teacher considerations and class size. The objective of the process is to produce the most “workable” heterogeneous combination of student groups. This important task contributes significantly to the creation of a positive class environment, which enables students to function to the fullest of their abilities. Staff members are assigned to these classes during the summer based upon the best possible “match” of teaching skills and interpersonal needs of students. Parents may still feel the need to share specific concerns/information about their child’s learning situation in regard to this placement process. All parental concerns are important to us here at JCN and this like all others will be heard and taken into account as part of the total educational process of your child. There will be a two week “window” during the spring of each year when parents can make specific requests known. By U.S.D. #339 Board of Education policy, the parent/guardian must have a personal meeting with the building principal to outline the specific request.
